Slideshows (upgrade)

As promised, we've added two new treatments to the JGallery module we introduced with the last upgrade. If you don't have this module, let us know and we'll add it.



Admin Refresh (upgrade)

Continuing our admin refresh, we've added the ability to select different icon sets for the control panel.



Meta Tags (new)

The new Meta Tags module lets you quickly customize search engine meta-data on a per page and per article basis.



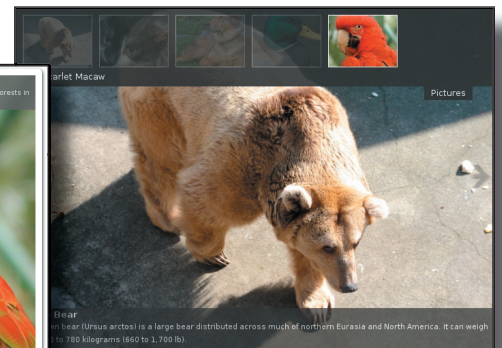
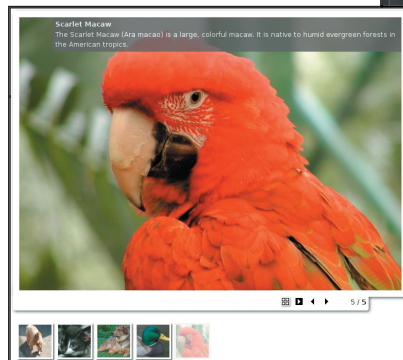
Functionality & Technology (advanced users)

- HTML Editor has been upgraded to improve performance and make it compatible with IE9

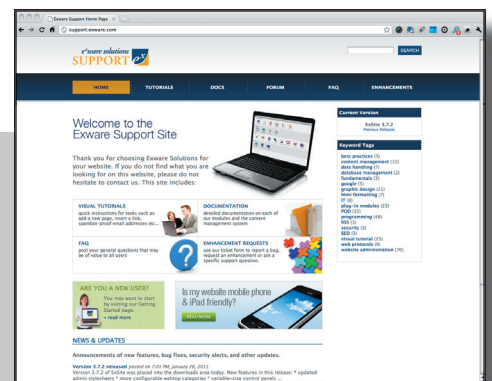
